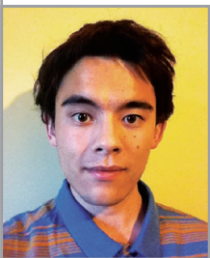


SHAUN LEWINSON

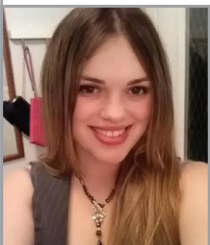

spare time, Rebecca works on promoting her first aid company, volunteering, and reading.

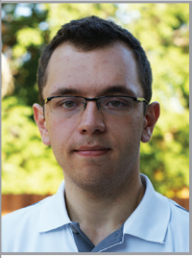


REID LOBSON
