Mill Street Brew Pub

Officially opened in December 2002, the brewery began in an original tank house within the historic Gooderham & Worts Distillery complex, now known as the Historic Distillery District. Built in the late 1870s, the building is a well-preserved example of classic Victorian industrial architecture. Mill Street's 6,000-sq.-ft. space includes an open-concept brewery, sampling bar, retail store and event space. The venue features 18-ft. ceilings and four enormous skylights, and is available for group functions.

- The Dining Room is perfect for large group functions of up to 110 for a sit down meal or 150 for a standup cocktail reception

- The Tank House Patio - Located on the north side of the pub this area is suitable for up to 55 people for a stand up cocktail reception or sit down meal. This patio is only available for exclusive bookings when you are renting the whole facility.

- The Brewery Patio - Located on the south side of the pub this area is suitable for summer time gatherings of up to 88 people for a stand up cocktail reception or sit down meal. This area is only available exclusively when you are also booking the main dining area.
