

Canadian Parking Association Covid-19 Health & Safety Policy

Masks must be worn at all times when in the conference venue, except while actively eating and drinking. All food must be consumed while seated.

Hand Sanitising stations will be present in all locations in the conference area. Frequent hand washing is recommended.

Social Distancing protocols will be practiced throughout the conference venue.

Seating in the meeting rooms will be limited to the same seat for the full day of events. Seats may be changed at the start of each day only, as deep cleaning will only happen overnight. Place cards will be issued to each attendee to show their reserved seats for the day.

Self-Assessment must be done before entering the conference area. If you are showing any of the following physical symptoms, do not enter the area:

Fever, dry cough, tiredness, aches and pains, sore throat, diarrhea, red eyes, headache,
loss of taste or smell, skin rash.

Have you been in close contact with a positive Covid-19 case in the last 14 days? If yes, do not enter the area.

Vaccinations: All conference attendees must show proof of having received two doses of an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine to be allowed into the conference venue.

What counts as acceptable proof of vaccination?

Travelling within the province of BC – your personal BC Vaccine card showing a second dose has been administered plus one piece of Government-issued photo ID.

Travelling within Canada but outside of BC - Along with a Government-issued photo ID, you must present valid proof of vaccine that is currently sanctioned by your province. The proof of vaccine must show that a second dose has been administered. Depending on your province, acceptable formats include the physical record provided to you upon vaccination, a photo of that immunization record or an electronic record.
